*Many of the courses in the Arts and Humanities and Social, Behavioral, and Economic Sciences arenas, emphasize national diversity (designated "N" at the end of the course title), or international and multi-cultural diversity (designated "I" at the end of the course title). Some courses emphasize both national diversity, and international and multi-cultural diversity (designated "D" at the end of the course title). Students must include at least one "N" course and one "I" course in their Integrative Studies programs. A "D" course may meet either an "N" or an "I" requirement but not both.

Students are eligible to apply for post-baccalaureate internships at an approved hospital program and are qualified to take the national certification exam after their clinical experience.

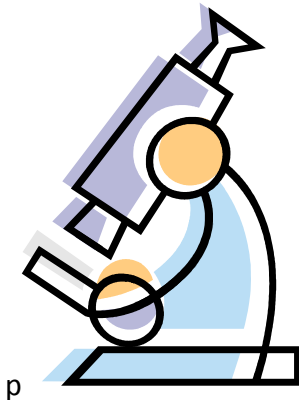

How to Schedule an Advising Appointment

1. Go to <http://msu.campus.eab.com> and login with your MSU NetID and password.
2. Once you are logged in, you will see a blue box in the upper right hand corner that says “Get Advising”. Click that.
3. Once you click “Get Advising”, you will be transferred to a new page which prompts you to select the college in which you wish to get advising

from. Use the drop down menu and select “Natural Science Advising”. A second drop down menu will appear and you will select “Biomedical Laboratory Science”. Click next at the bottom right hand side of the page.

4. The next screen will allow you to pick the location you want to meet and with which advisor you wish to see. Select “North Kedzie Lab- Room 322” and then select from the list of advisors in the drop down menu. If you do not have a preference of which advisor you want to see, simply leave that space blank and click next.
5. The next page will have a calendar displaying the times and days available to have an advising appointment. Select the time and date that works for you and click next.
6. The last page is a confirmation page. It will outline the details of your appointment and allow you to write an optional note to your advisor regarding why you want to meet. Check over your appointment information and when everything is correct, click “Confirm”.

If you do not see an open time slot that works with your schedule, please email bld@msu.edu, and your email will be forwarded to the appropriate advisor.
